The Jefferson Awards for Public Service

We are looking for people who make a difference . . .
Individuals who have made the Southern Tier a better place for all of us.

To nominate a volunteer who has made our area a better place, simply fill out this form. A panel of judges will review the nominations and select five to receive a Jefferson Award Medallion at a special celebration. One of the five local award recipients will be chosen to represent our area at the national awards event in Washington DC, June 2019.

Nominee Criteria:

- Nominees must either live or provide volunteer services within Chemung, Schuyler, or Steuben counties.
- The nominee must serve in a volunteer capacity and must not be paid or compensated for the work featured in their application (i.e. Educator, Minister, Paid Coach).
- The nominee must be 18 years of age or older.
- The nominee must be still living at the time the nomination is submitted.
- Elected officials are exempt from nomination.

Nominee Information:

Please be aware, it is likely that the panel of Judges will not know your nominee. Therefore we ask that you provide information that will give a complete understanding of the impact your nominee has made within our community.

To make a nomination please complete the nomination form and attach at least 3, but no more than 6, letters of reference which highlight the contributions that your nominee has made to an agency, organization, or your community. We would encourage the writer to limit their letter of reference to 500 words, but to be as specific as possible in an effort to quantify the nominee's accomplishments. Other supporting documents: copies of resumes, newspaper stories or clippings, newsletters, etc. We will be unable to return copies of your submission, so please do not include any documents you would want returned.

The selection committee will not be contacting the individual making the nomination, the nominee, or any person providing a letter of reference, for additional information. Therefore we encourage you to make your application as complete as possible.

Supporting documents, letters, resumes, and/or published articles about the nominee are strongly encouraged. Please do not send originals, as we cannot return the materials.
